Dearly beloved brothers in Christ, our Lord:

I cannot fail to communicate to all of you, at this present "hour," the words received from the Lord, so that each one may become ever more conscious of the "moment" that has been our lot to live, and may consciously make his choice: God or the creatures; the Divine or the human; the Being or the "self."

For more than twenty years I have been waiting for this moment, marked by the Lord, in order to transmit to all souls of good will the "Messages" I have received, which announce to us what we are now living and give us the light to make our definitive choice.

In face of the events we are witnessing, let us always keep in mind that we should not judge any person; rather, we should denounce whatever our conscience sees as negative, rejecting it as a part of ourselves with which we cannot identify, and which we leave to God's Justice and Judgment.

Due to questions that have arisen in relation to some points of the Messages, I have added footnotes for the purpose of clarifying or expressing in a more explicit way what I had understood at the moment of receiving them. When a message is received directly, what is received is the intuition, the understanding of the deepest meaning of the

intuited Word, but many times the word used does not express the entire content of what is meant to be communicated. For example, when the Messages speak of "heart," everyone knows that this does not refer to the physical heart but is a symbol that expresses love, affection, etc.; this same thing, however, will be understood by each one according to the experiences he may have had in his life, and though these experiences may be very deep, the person will always remain on a human level, for if he has not had the same intuition of the Divine, he will not understand the reality that has been intuited in the Message. This is why the divine Word received through intuition is never exhausted in its content and will always tell us something new at every time and in every circumstance. Therefore, the footnotes have the same value as the Message.

May our Lord Jesus Christ and the Virgin Mary, our mother in the spirit, models of life for each one of us — lives of self-denial and identification with the Divine Will — together with all the souls who have lived out the self-denial in order to identify themselves with the Divine, assist us in our "pilgrimage" so that we may be able to remain faithful to the end.
